

Nursery 1 have been doing some fabulous animal mark making this week. We had a very "stompy" time making animal footprints, listening to and joining in with animal

songs. We also had a very squashy time exploring all the sensory story objects for "A squash and a squeeze."



Nursery 2 This week Nursery 2 have been learning

all about animals. We have done some super counting. We were great at finding the correct number card once we had counted together. We have also been sorting animals into "big" and "small" - we even tried medium! We loved joining up with our friends in Nursery 1 for a messy writing session - the frogspawn was our favourite! Whitelow 1 It has been very exciting and busy in Whitelow 1 as we continued to celebrate World Book Day. The children enjoyed listening to the story "Cave Baby" and have had fun



dressing up as some of their favourite characters. We have been experimenting with jelly babies, placing them in different solutions, e.g. sugar, salt, oil and baking powder. We watched the babies change over time until they eventually disappeared. We have been using different materials to make marks and decorate the various animals in the story in the style of "Cave Baby".

**Whitelow 2** This week in Whitelow 2 we have been doing butterfly art, singing and

activities as well as reading about butterflies in our stories and counting butterflies and caterpillars in Maths. In Science we used special, absorbent paper to create beautiful pat-



terns that became beautiful butterfly wings.


